Highlights

Sixth Economic Census in A & N Islands

- Economic Census is a complete count of all establishments engaged in production and/or distribution of goods and services not for the purpose of sole consumption.
- All establishments engaged in various agricultural and non-agricultural activities excluding crop production, plantation, public administration, defence and compulsory social security were counted.
- Economic Census was conducted in 993 Enumeration Blocks by 99 Statistical Staff covering all households in all villages and islands of Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Fieldwork was conducted during October, 2013 to January, 2014
- Total number of establishment counted is 23450.
- Nearly 63.05% of the establishments belong to rural area.
- Nearly 36.95% of the establishments belong to urban area.
- About 57.85% of the establishments operate from outside household with fixed structure.
- About 30.12% of the establishments operate from outside household without a fixed structure.
- About 12.03% of the establishments operate from inside the household.
- About 0.75% of the establishments are engaged in handicraft/ handloom activities.
- Data for handicraft/ handloom establishment was collected for the first time in this Economic Census.
- 84.89% increase observed in number of establishments over last Economic Census (2005).
- 69034 persons found employed/ engaged in establishments.
- 75.08% increase in workers over last Economic Census (2005).
- 55% workers are employed in rural areas.
- 58.75% are hired workers.
- 27.66% are female workers.
- 917 establishments had workers more than 8.

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SIXTH ECONOMIC CENSUS

1. Introduction

Economic Census (EC) is the complete count of all establishments (i.e. engaged in production and/or distribution of goods and services not for the purpose of sole consumption) located within the geographical boundaries of the country. In India five Economic Censuses have been conducted in the past. These were conducted during 1977, 1980, 1990, 1998 and 2005. The Sixth EC was conducted during October, 2013 to January, 2014 by the Statistical Staff of A & N Administration under the overall guidance provided by Economic Census Unit of the Economic Statistics Division, Central Statistics Office (CSO), Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MOSPI), Government of India, New Delhi

The Sixth EC proposed to provide up to date information on number of establishments and number of persons employed therein, activity wise, of all the sector (excluding crop production, plantation, public administration, defence and compulsory social security) of the country including their distribution at all-India, State, District and at village/ward levels for comprehensive analysis of the structure of the economy (micro, macro and regional levels).

2. Objective

Main objectives for conduct of the Sixth Economic Census are as under:

- i. To provide detailed information on operational and economic variables, activity wise, of all the establishments (excluding crop production, plantation, public administration, defence and compulsory social security) of the country including its distribution at all-India, State and sub-State levels for comprehensive analysis of the structure of the economy and for benchmark purposes; to provide similar data at lower geographical levels like tehsils/villages in case of rural areas and towns/wards in case of urban areas for decentralized planning required under 73rd and 74th Constitutional Amendments;
- ii. To generate information on number of exporting establishments, employing 10 or more workers, activity wise and area wise in operation;
- iii. To provide information on number of workers working in establishments, activity wise and area wise in operation;
- iv. To provide information on number of workers working in unorganized sector (i.e. establishments employing less than ten workers);

- v. To provide updated Directory of Establishments employing 10 or more workers for local level planning purposes and also for using as a 'list frame' for conduct of survey of such establishments in the non-manufacturing/services sector; and
- vi. To provide an up to date 'area frame' containing information on number of establishments and number of workers by industry, by type of ownership of the establishments, etc at the village/ block level, from which sample villages/blocks could be drawn as the primary sampling units for collecting detailed information about the establishments in the follow-up sample surveys of establishments.

The activities covered in the Sixth Economic Census have a share of about 86% in total GDP of the country.

3. Scope and Coverage

The Sixth Economic Census was conducted in all the Tehsils and Islands of Andaman & Nicobar Islands along with the rest of the country. All economic activities (agricultural and non-agricultural), except those involved in crop production and plantation, public administration, defense and compulsory social security, related to production and/or distribution of goods and/or services other than for the sole purpose of own consumption were covered. However, as was done in earlier censuses, the following activities were kept out of the purview of the Sixth Economic Census:

- i. Establishments of shelter-less and nomadic population, which keep on moving from place to place and camp either without shelter or with makeshift shelter.
- ii. Establishments engaged in some illegal activities like smuggling, gambling, beggary, prostitution, etc.
- iii. Domestic servants, whether they work in one household or in a number of households, drivers, etc. who undertake jobs for others on wages.
- iv. All wage-paid employees of casual nature.
- v. Household members engaged in household chores.
- vi. Persons doing different types of jobs depending on the availability of work e.g. loading, unloading, helping a mason or a carpenter, doing earthwork for a contractor.
- vii. Household members working for other households and earning some money which is insignificant.
- viii. Households in which none of the members is engaged in any gainful activity i.e., households depending on remittance, rent, interest, pension etc.

4. Changes Made in the Sixth Economic Census

i) Coverage:

- The practice followed since the Second EC to cover all agricultural activities excluding crop production and plantation was continued in the Sixth EC;
- In case of non-agricultural activities, establishments engaged in public administration, defense and compulsory social security activities were excluded during Sixth EC as such information is already available with the Government and also due to the difficulties faced in collecting information from such establishments during the Fifth EC.

ii) Changes Made in the Schedules:

In Sixth EC two schedules were canvassed, viz., i) House and Establishment Listing Schedule(6A) and ii) Directory of Establishment Schedule (6C) in place of three schedules canvassed during Fifth EC. House and Establishment Listing Schedule of Sixth EC was formed by merging **‘House List’** and **‘Enterprise Schedule’ of the Fifth EC**. Further, the **‘Address Slip’** Schedule of Fifth EC was modified and renamed **as Directory of Establishment Schedule** in Sixth EC for developing Business Register.

The third schedule ‘Establishment Abstract’ (Schedule 6B) was a derived schedule of summary information based on the information contained in House and Establishment Listing Schedule, which was required to be prepared by each enumerator. This summary information has been used to generate provisional results contained in this report.

iii) Inclusion of New Items/Changes made in Main Schedule i.e., House and Establishment Listing Schedule:

- a. Number of members in the household (HH);
- b. Number of only wage earners/salaried employees in the HH;
- c. Number of establishments outside HH with fixed structure owned by HH members;
- d. Number of establishments outside HH without fixed structure owned by HH members;
- e. Number of establishments inside HH owned by HH members;
(Items under ‘a’ to ‘e’ above were included at the household level to guard against possible under-listing of establishments located within the household or those without fixed structure)
- f. Broad activity code (all activities divided into two-digit 24 broad activity codes);

- g. Three-digit NIC Codes recorded in place of four-digit NIC codes earlier, to minimize wrong reporting of NIC codes;
 - h. Data collected for handicraft/handloom establishments for the first time;
 - i. Information on ownership of proprietary establishments collected for transgender for the first time;
 - j. Religion of the owner of proprietary establishments;
 - k. Nature of operation: 'Non perennial' was divided into casual and seasonal; and
 - l. Bar Codes along with Form Number were used for the first time to facilitate proper accounting of canvassed schedules.
- iv) Items Excluded from the Main Schedule i.e., House and Establishment Listing Schedule:
- a. Information on subsidiary activity (only information on major activity collected);
 - b. Power used in entrepreneurial activity (confined to Directory of Establishment schedule);
 - c. Registration code (confined to Directory of Establishment schedule);
 - d. Number of children (male/female) usually working.
- v) New Items Added in Directory of Establishment Schedule:
- a. Does a computer and/or internet facility exist in the establishment?
 - b. Whether using power in production of goods and services?
 - c. Whether an exporting unit?
 - d. Address of main office along with that of branch office with PAN and TAN numbers
 - e. Registration information under 9 codes.

A BRIEF OF SIXTH ECONOMIC CENSUS IN ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ISLANDS

Endeavour of Directorate of Economics & Statistics was to cover 91621 households in 993 Enumeration Blocks including the remotest part of the UT. 62 Enumerators and 37 Supervisors canvassed the schedules in each household/establishments in their assigned areas, ascertaining the economic activity being carried out inside the household or even outside the household at a separate location.

Response gathered from the members of household were tabulated in prescribed schedules i.e., 6A (Households & Establishments schedule) and 6C (Directory of Establishment schedule).

Enumerators even covered the areas in tribal belt, where due to shifting/ migrating nature of households the habitations which were found un-inhabited were listed as un-inhabited during survey. In some islands only the institutional households (Police out Post) were found i.e., Tillang Chong Island & Mile Tilek etc. Thus, they were listed accordingly.

Economic activity of households can be carried out in various forms, such as inside the household or outside the household. After this categorization next objective was to identify how the activity is being carried out at outside household i.e., whether it is being carried out at a fixed structure or without a fixed structure. This data further provides the estimates of number of establishments where economic activity is being carried out in a fixed structure or without fixed structure. It is only through such Economic Census various data on “unorganized Sector” can be collected.

As we are aware that in any locality hordes of economic activities are carried out at pavements, roadside etc “street food” often appears in vocabulary. But these activities are without any fixed structure and thus often remain uncounted /unregistered or this is referred to as “unorganized” Sector. To reach this unorganized sector economic census was introduced way back in 1977 in India.

In this Economic Census, Directory of establishments with eight or more workers covering all the habitations will be compiled.

Overall this census offers a frame for follow up surveys in order to study the changes in the unorganized sectors of economy.

Since the establishment having a fixed structure i.e. with a building are supposed to be listed somewhere, thereby implying that these are invariably registered with one or the other registering authorities under various acts as the case may be.

Through Economic Census an estimate can also be generated on the awareness about various Registrations Acts etc among the households.

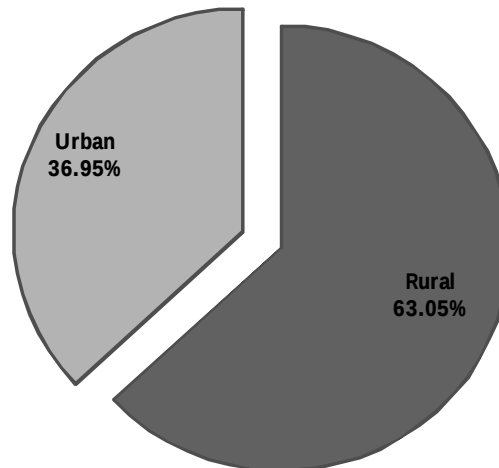

Establishments

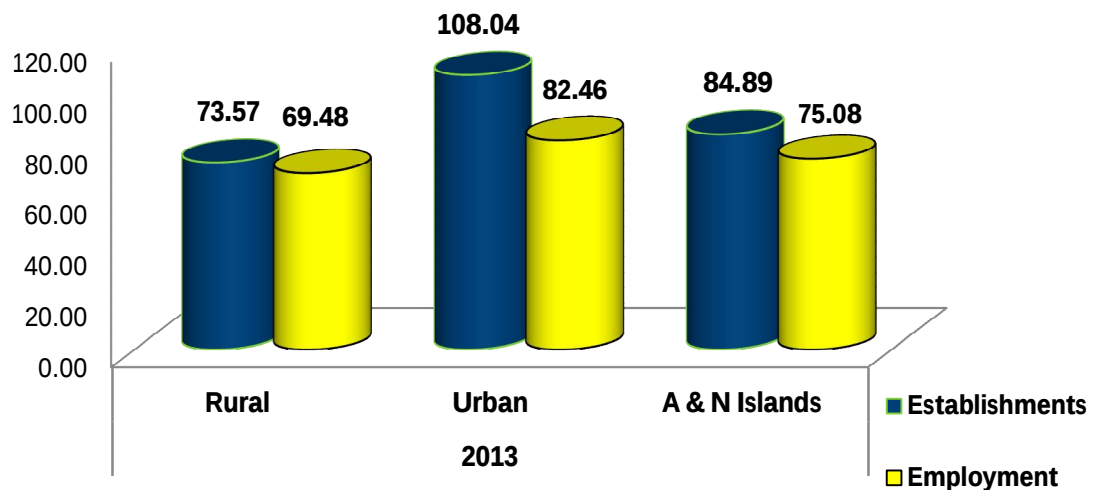
There are 23450 establishments in A & N Islands found engaged in different economic activities other than crop production, plantation, public administration, defence & compulsory social security services. Out of which, 14785 establishments (63.05%) are in rural areas and 8665 establishments (36.95%) are in the urban areas.

The overall growth in number of establishments during the intervening period of Fifth EC (2005) and Sixth EC (2013) is 84.89%. Percentage growth in number of establishments in the rural and urban areas of the UT is 73.57% and 108.04% respectively.

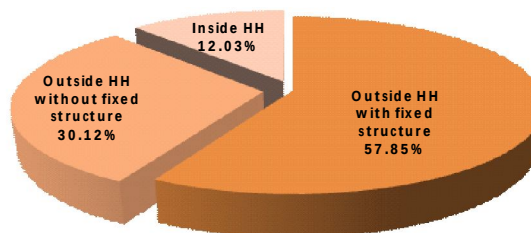
Growth rate (%) over Fifth Economic Census



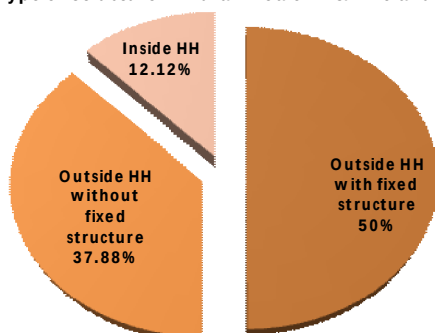

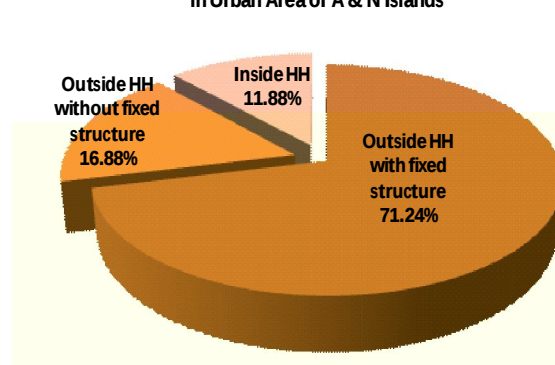
Percentage Distribution of Establishments by Type of Structure in A & N Islands

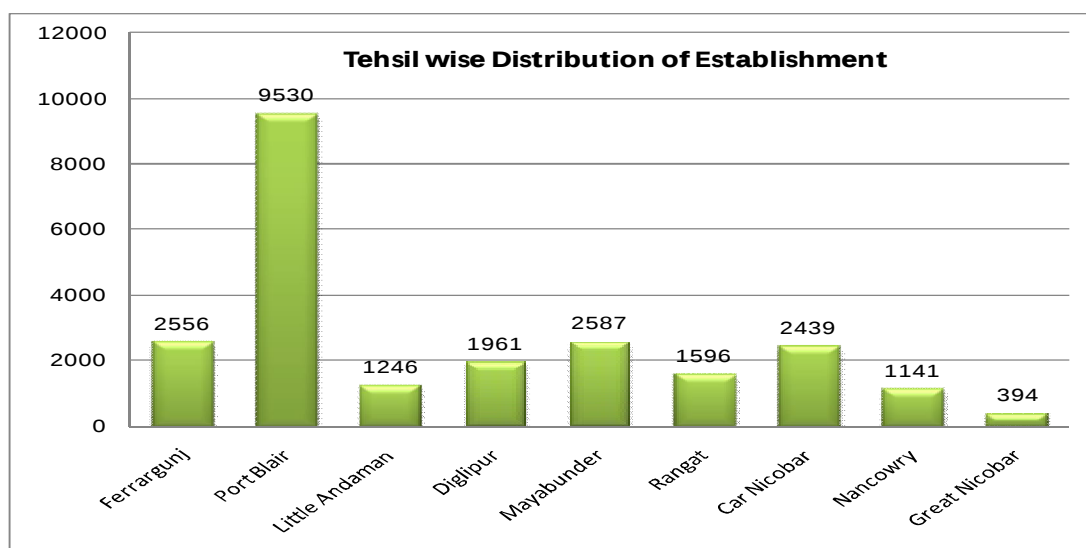


Percentage Distribution of Establishments by Type of Structure in Rural Area of A & N Islands

Highest number of establishments were observed in South Andaman District 13332 (56.85%) followed by North & Middle Andaman District 6144 (26.20%) & Nicobar District 3974 (16.95%). Highest percentage of establishments was found in Port Blair Tehsil (40.64%) followed by Mayabunder Tehsil (11.03%), Ferrargunj Tehsil (10.90%), Car Nicobar Tehsil (10.40%), Diglipur Tehsil (8.36%), Rangat Tehsil (6.81%), Little Andaman Tehsil (5.31%), Nancowry Tehsil (4.87%) & Great Nicobar Tehsil (1.68%) in that order.

Type of Establishments:

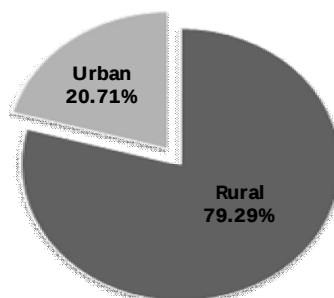
There are 20630 establishments operating outside of households, 12994 (62.99%) in rural and 7636 (37.01%) in urban area of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Among the establishments functioning outside the household the highest percentage was found in South Andaman District (56.60%) followed by North & Middle Andaman District (25.67%) & Nicobar District (17.73%). Highest percentage of establishments operating outside of household was found in Port Blair Tehsil (40.72%) followed by Car Nicobar Tehsil (11.37%), Ferrargunj Tehsil (11.13%), Mayabunder Tehsil (10.73%), Diglipur Tehsil (8.39%), Rangat Tehsil (6.55%), Nancowry Tehsil (4.85%), Little Andaman Tehsil (4.75%), & Great Nicobar Tehsil (1.51%) in that order.

In Economic Census the establishments functioning outside the households have been categorized into two types i.e., establishment having a fixed structure and those functioning without a fixed structure. Fixed structures can be counted but those without a fixed structure are difficult to be counted. Thus, it is mainly through the economic census only that such establishments representing the unorganized sector are counted.

Establishments Outside Household Without Fixed Structure:

Total of 7064 (30.12%) establishments found to be operating from outside of household and without fixed structure in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Out of 7064 establishments, 5601 (79.29%) are in rural and 1463 (20.71%) are in urban areas of A & N Islands.

6th EC, 2013**

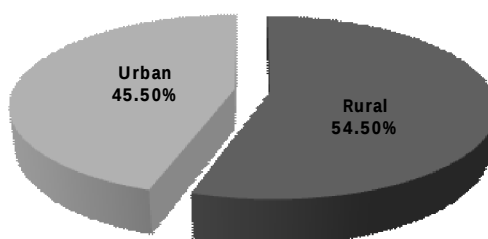


Number of establishments without fixed structure in South Andaman District is 2316 (32.79%), in North & Middle Andaman District 1855 (26.26%) & in Nicobar District 2893 (40.95%). Highest percentage of establishments without fixed structure was found in Car Nicobar Tehsil (30.39%), followed by Port Blair Tehsil (21.94%), Mayabunder Tehsil (18.71%), Nancowry Tehsil (9.99%), Ferrargunj Tehsil (8.65%), Diglipur Tehsil (4.82%), Rangat Tehsil (2.73%), Little Andaman Tehsil (2.20%), & in Great Nicobar Tehsil (0.57%) in that order.

Establishments outside Household With Fixed Structure:

There are 13566 establishments (57.85 % of the total number of establishments) found to be operating from outside household with fixed structure in the UT. Out of these 13566 establishments, 7393 (54.50%) establishments are in rural areas and 6173 (45.50%) establishments are in urban areas.

Employment according to 6th Economic Census, 2013**

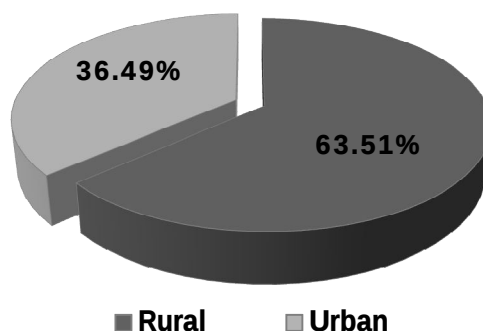


Number of establishments with fixed structure was highest in South Andaman District 9360 (69.00%) followed by North & Middle Andaman District 3441 (25.36%) & Nicobar District 765 (5.64%). Highest percentage of establishments with fixed structure was found in Port Blair Tehsil (50.49%) followed by Ferrargunj Tehsil (12.43%), Diglipur Tehsil (10.25%), Rangat Tehsil (8.54%), Mayabunder Tehsil (6.57%), Little Andaman Tehsil (6.08%), Nancowry Tehsil (2.17%), Great Nicobar Tehsil (2.01%) & in Car Nicobar Tehsil (1.46%).

Establishments Inside Household:

There are 2820 establishments (12.03 % of the total number of establishments) found to be operating from inside household in the UT. Out of these 2820 establishments, 1791 (64%) establishments are in rural areas and 1029 (36%) establishments are in urban areas.

No. of Establishment Inside HH

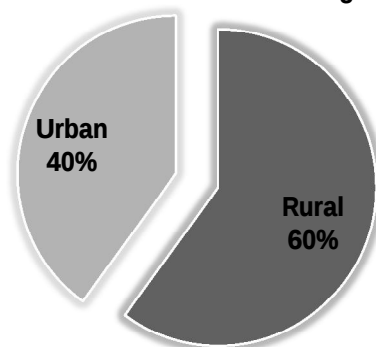


Highest number of establishments operating inside households were found in South Andaman District is 1656 (58.72%), in North & Middle Andaman District 848 (30.07%) & in Nicobar District 316 (11.21%). Highest percentage of establishment inside household was found in Port Blair Tehsil (40.07%) followed by Mayabunder Tehsil (13.23%), Little Andaman Tehsil (9.47%), Ferrargunj Tehsil (9.18%), Rangat Tehsil (8.65%), Diglipur Tehsil (8.19%), Nancowry Tehsil (4.97%), Car Nicobar Tehsil (3.33%) & in Great Nicobar Tehsil (2.91%).

Handicraft / Handloom Establishments:

Data for handicraft/ handloom establishment was collected for the first time in this Sixth Economic Census. There are 175 handicraft/handloom establishments, accounting 0.75% of the total number of establishments in the UT. Out of these 175 handicraft/handloom establishments, 105 (60%) establishments are in rural areas and 70 (40 %) establishments are in urban areas.

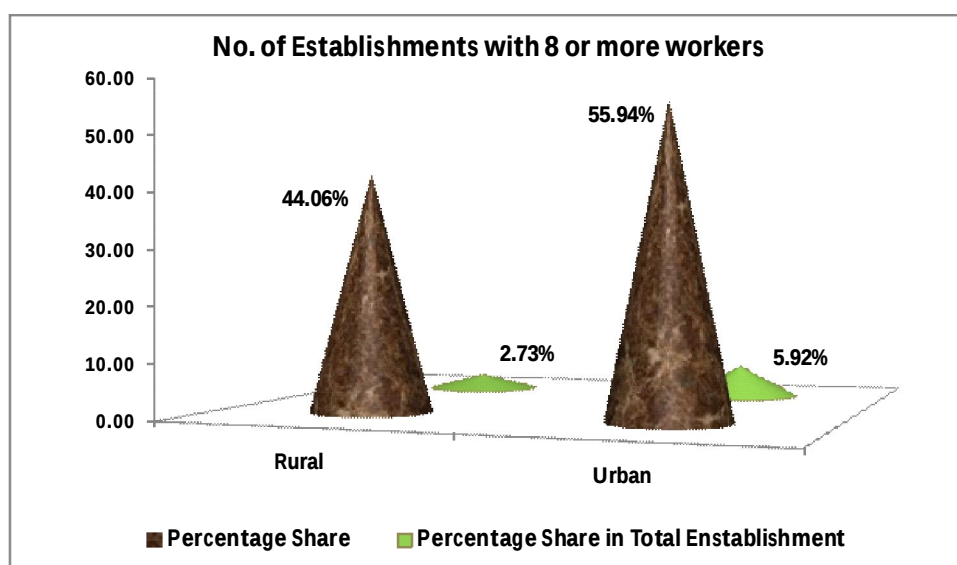
Handicraft/ Handloom Establishments Percentage Share of Rural & Urban in A&N Islands according 6th EC, 2013



Number of handicraft/handloom establishments in South Andaman District is 98 (56.00%), in North & Middle Andaman District 36 (20.57%) & in Nicobar District 41 (23.43%). Highest percentage of handicraft/handloom establishments was found in Port Blair Tehsil (41.71%) followed by Car Nicobar Tehsil (21.71%), Mayabunder Tehsil (13.71%), Little Andaman Tehsil (9.71%), Diglipur Tehsil (5.71%), Ferrargunj Tehsil (4.57%), Great Nicobar Tehsil (1.71%), Rangat Tehsil (1.14%) & Nil in Nancowry Tehsil.

Establishments with 8 or more workers:

Establishments can be of various types, but all require manpower. Thus certain establishments are managed by the members of households themselves, others hire workers. During 5th Economic Census a new schedule was introduced as “address slip”. This was to compile the directory of larger establishments (at least one hired worker) employing 10 workers or more. But in Sixth Economic Census this has been reduced as the establishments having 8 or more workers. These were compiled through 6C schedules. There are 917 establishments with 8 or more workers, accounting to 3.91% of total number of establishments in the UT. Out of these 917 establishments, 404 (44.06%) establishments are in rural areas and 513 (55.94%) establishments are in urban areas.

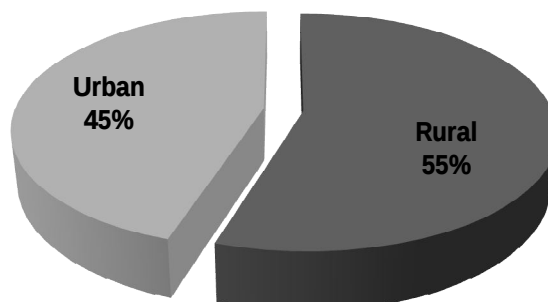


Highest number of establishments employing 8 or more workers was observed in South Andaman District is 693 (75.57%) followed by North & Middle Andaman District 161 (17.56%) & Nicobar District 63 (6.87%). Highest percentage of establishments employing 8 or more workers was found in Port Blair Tehsil (62.49%) followed by Ferrargunj Tehsil (7.96%), Rangat Tehsil (6.22%), Mayabunder Tehsil (6%), Diglipur Tehsil (5.34%), Little Andaman Tehsil (5.13%), Nancowry Tehsil (3.05%), Car Nicobar Tehsil (2.07%) & in Great Nicobar Tehsil (1.74%).

Employment

Total number of 69034 persons found to be employed in 23450 establishments (excluding crop production, plantation, public administration, defense & compulsory social security services activities), out of which, 37967 persons (55%) are employed in rural areas and 31067 persons (45%) are employed in the urban areas.

Percentage Share of Rural & Urban in A&N Islands in Total Employment according to 6th Economic Census, 2013

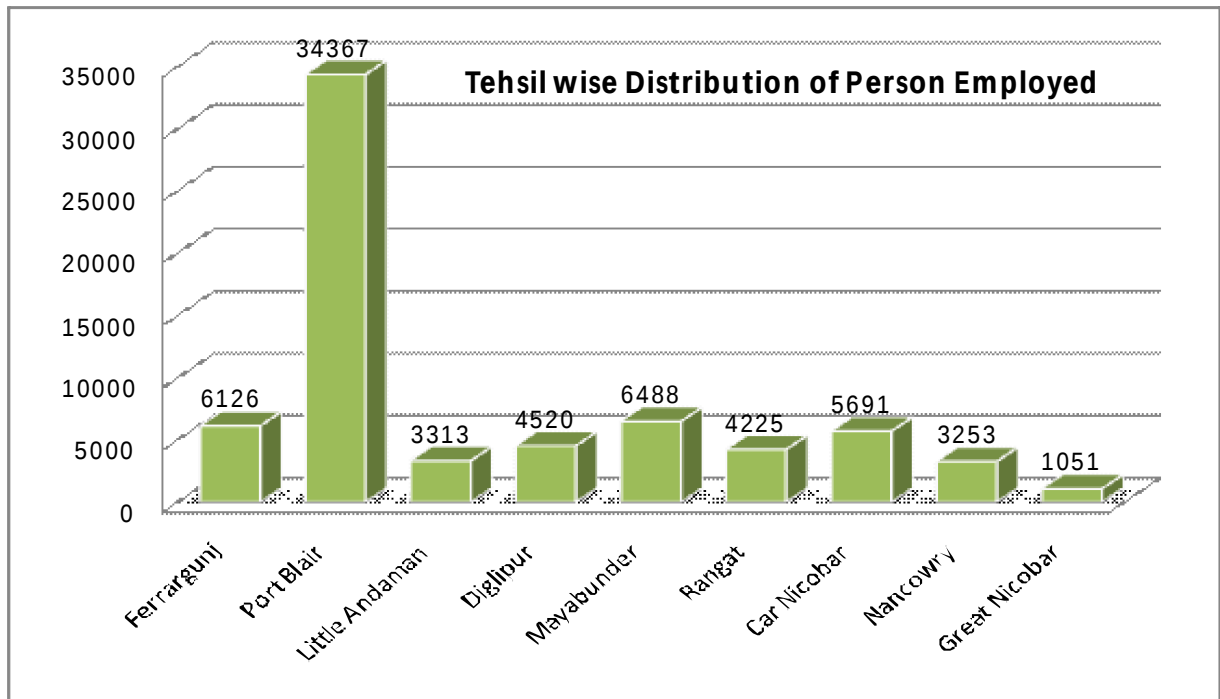


The overall growth in number of employment during the intervening period of Fifth EC (2005) and Sixth EC (2013) is 75.08%. Corresponding percentage growth in number of employment in the rural and urban areas of the UT are 69.48% and 82.46% respectively.

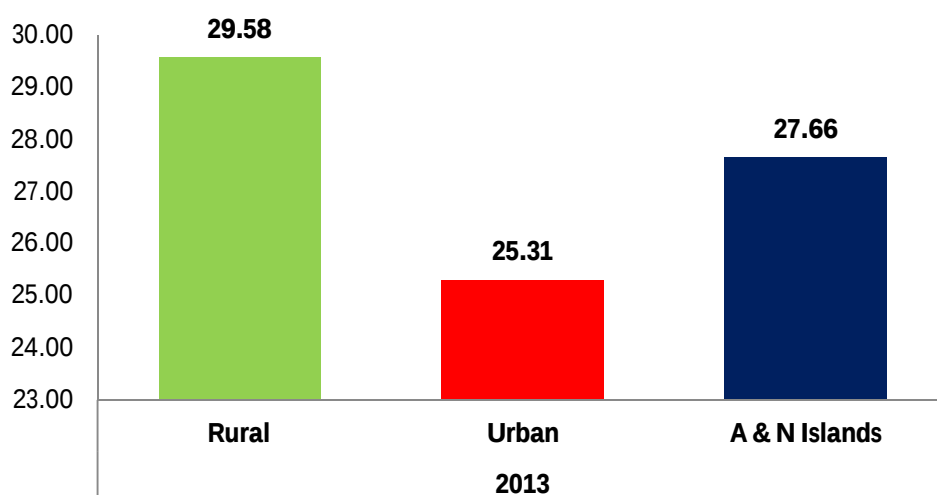

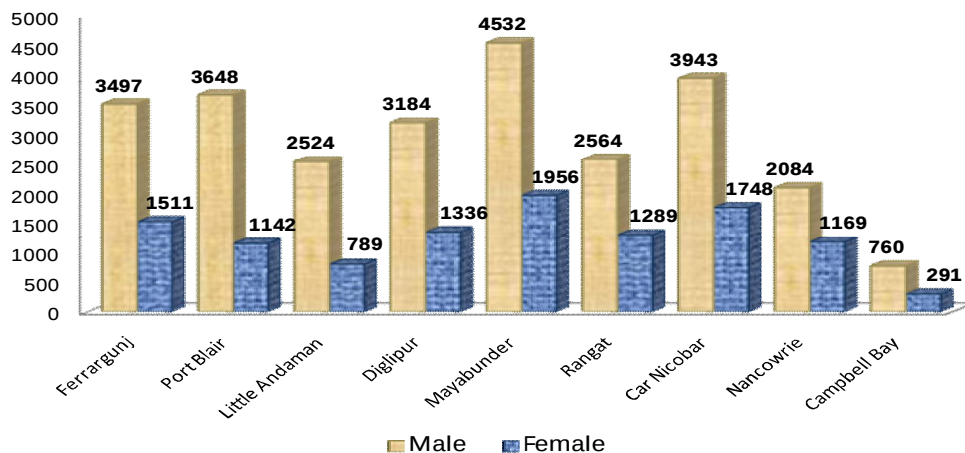

Percentage of total female workers in the total persons employed

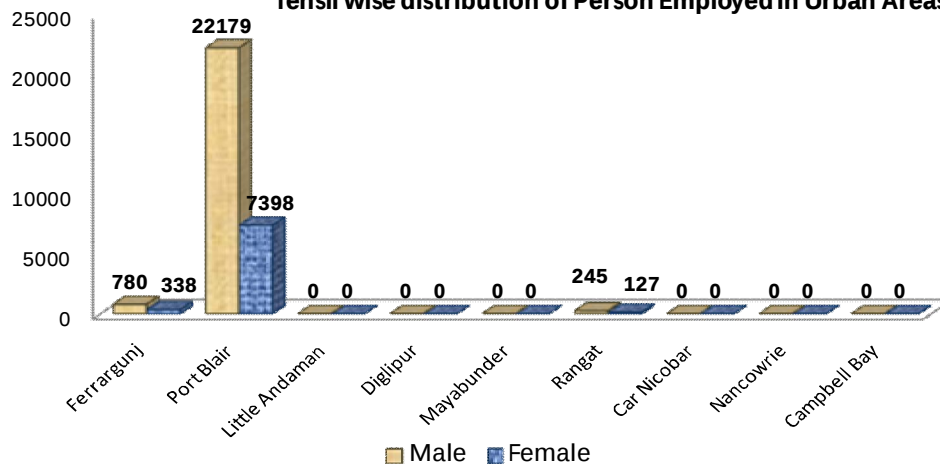

Tehsil wise distribution of Person Employed in Urban Areas.

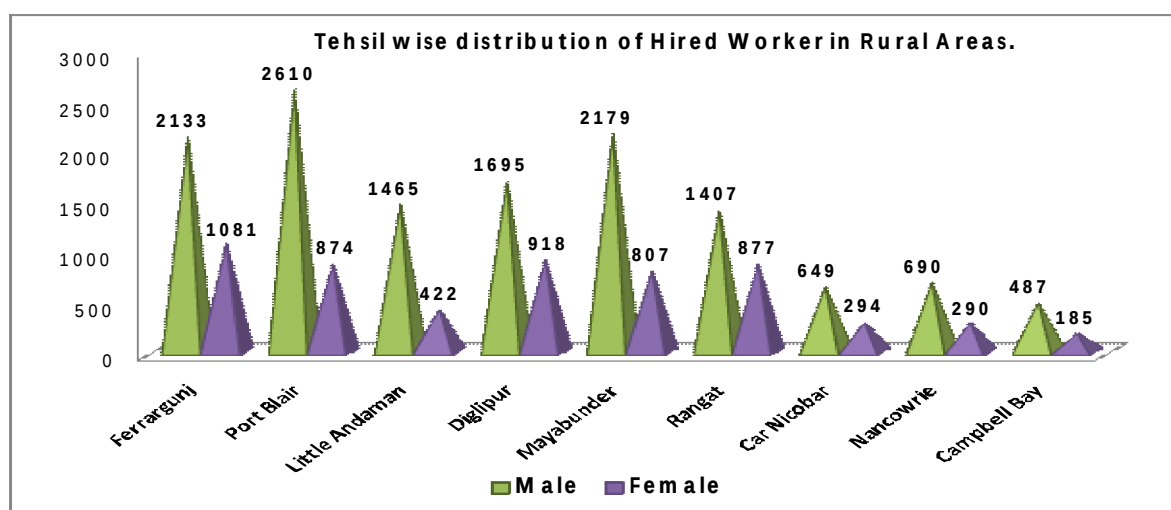


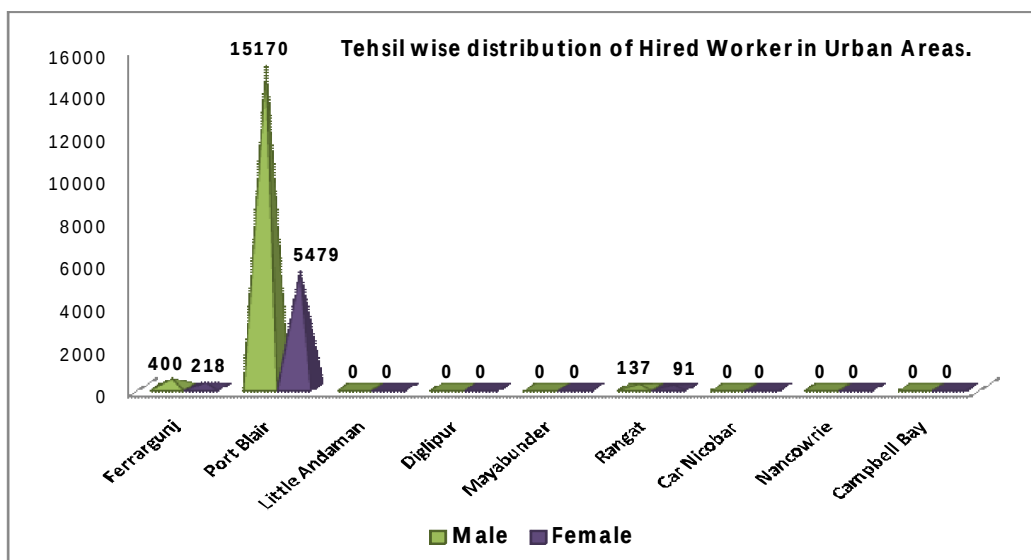

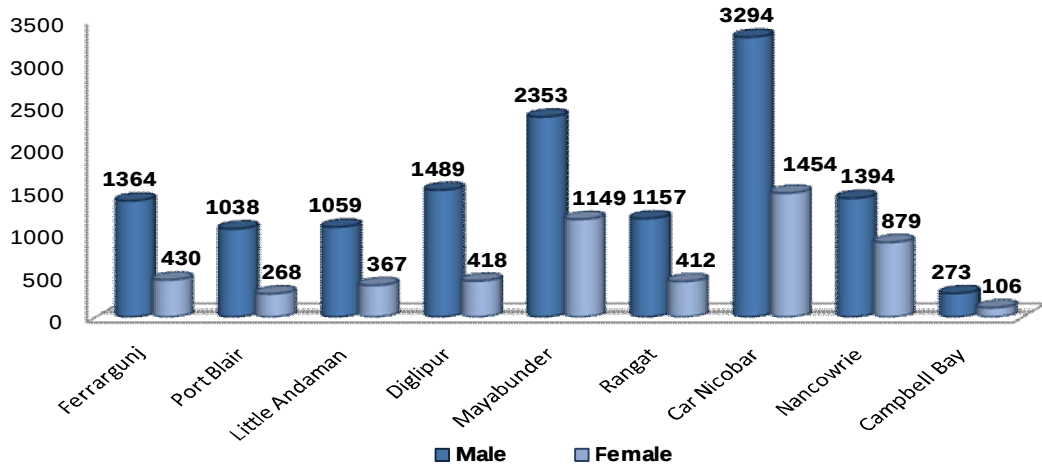

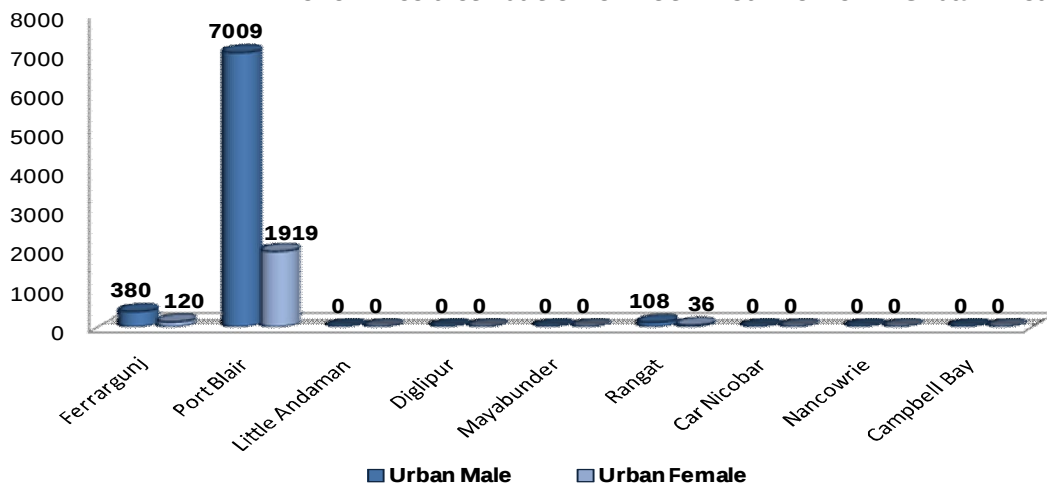

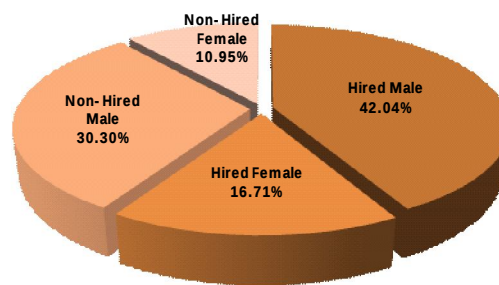
Tehsil wise distribution of Not-Hired Worker in Rural Areas.



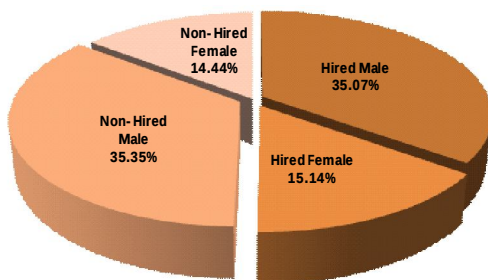
Tehsil wise distribution of Not-Hired Worker in Urban Areas.
